



**Foreign National Deemed Export
Compliance Verification (Form I-129)**

U.S. Export control laws, including the Export Administration Regulations (EAR) and the International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR), prohibit the disclosure, including oral or visual, or transfer of controlled technical data to foreign persons, whether in the U.S. or abroad. In accordance with these regulations, the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) requires that all employers identify whether a foreign national (FN) employee will have exposure to controlled technology or technical data.

As required by the USCIS, each I-129 petitioner is required to certify that it has reviewed the EAR and ITAR with respect to the release of technology or technical data, and determined that a license is either not required from the U.S. government, or is required and UNLV will prevent access to the controlled technology until a license is obtained.

To ensure UNLV's compliance with visa and export laws, please complete the following information and checklist and attach a brief job description for the applicant.
